SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCES

The CMS continued to produce concerts in schools and with external partners until the end of the summer term. The summer term Thames Reach Youth Orchestra (TRY) concert was held at the Royal Opera House West Barn Purfleet. Pupils from Barking & Dagenham and Thurrock concluded a successful 23/24 concert season performing a wide range of music including Jean de Florette by Petit, Blank Space by Swift and Finale by Shakar. On July 18th the Summer term CMS "Live" concerts took place in eight primary schools. A brass and a woodwind group visited schools to perform well know music and to give an opportunity for pupils to hear the instruments "live" and learn how they perform together. Over a thousand pupils were entertained during the concerts.
